Grant Radbourne of Massey, Ontario, pled guilty to charges related to childhood sexual abuse in mid-2007.

According to our sources, he was given one year of house arrest. A worker in Ontario at the time, Maurice Close, was questioned as part of the court case. He was reportedly admonished by the court for not reporting Grant's crimes, but no charges were filed against Maurice.

Also according to our source, a letter was distributed to elders in the area after this case was completed, informing elders and church members that all abuse needs to be reported to police.

We've been informed that since his sentence was completed, Grant has been attending all church gatherings with no restrictions, as well as having meeting in his home.
